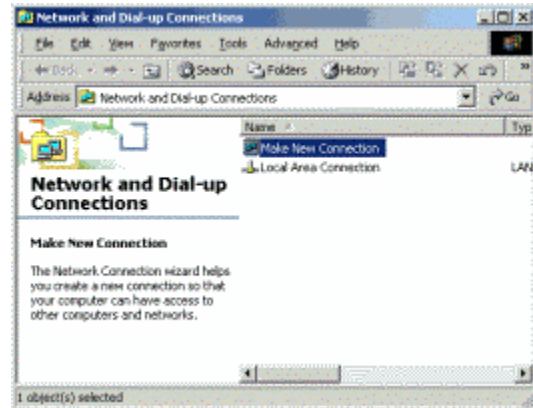




## Windows 2000 Dialup Settings

1. Click **Start**, click **Settings**, **Network and Dial-up Connections** icons.
2. Double-click the **Make New Connection** icon.
3. Click the **Next** button if there is a **Welcome Screen** (sometimes there isn't; if not go the next step).
4. Select **Dial-up to the Internet**.
5. Click the **Next** button.



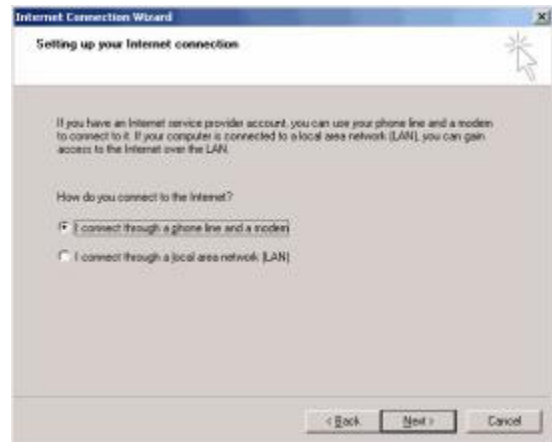
6. Select the **manual** setup option.

7. Click the **Next** button



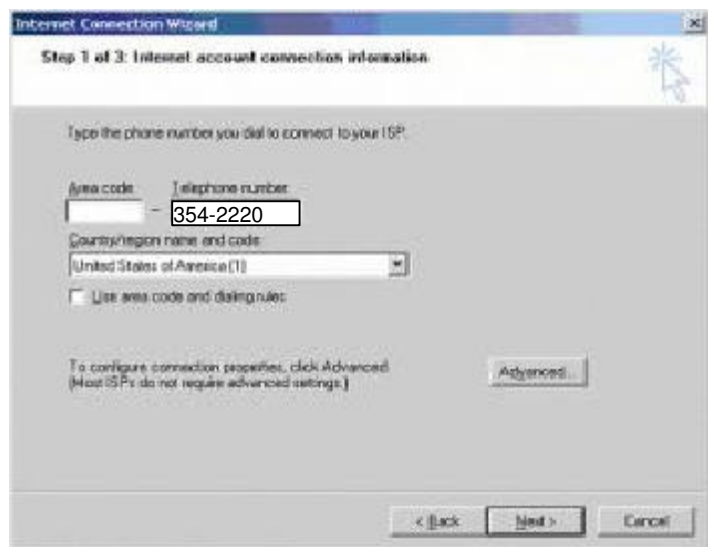
8. Make sure that **I connect through a phone line and a modem** is selected as seen below.

9. Click the **Next** button



10. Leave the area code blank and enter 354-2220 for the phone number.

11. Click the **Advanced** button

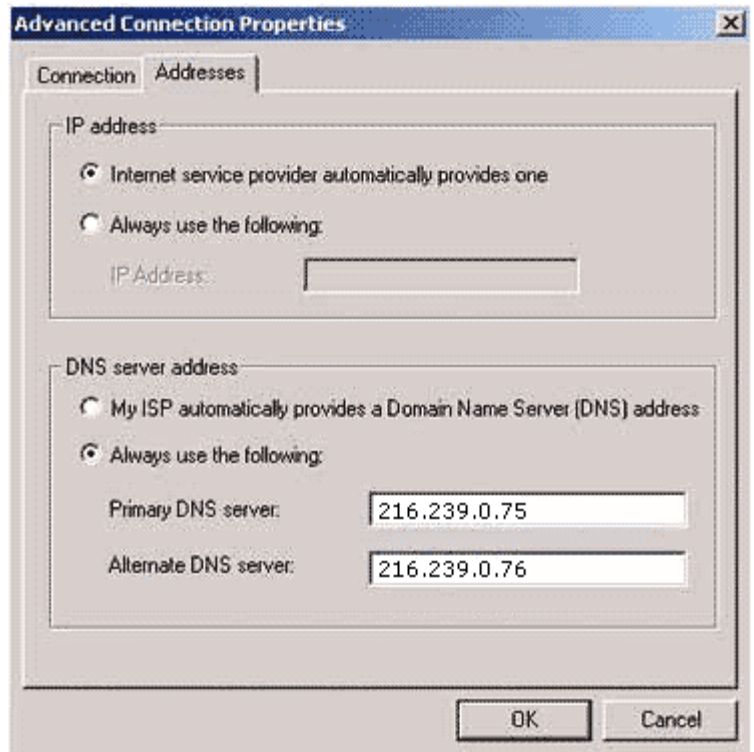


12. Make sure **Internet service provider automatically provides one** is selected under the **IP Address** section.

13. Click on the **Addresses** tab and select **Always use the following:** under **DNS server address**. Enter **216.239.0.75** in the Primary DNS Server and **216.239.0.76** in the Secondary DNS Server.

14. Click the **OK** button.

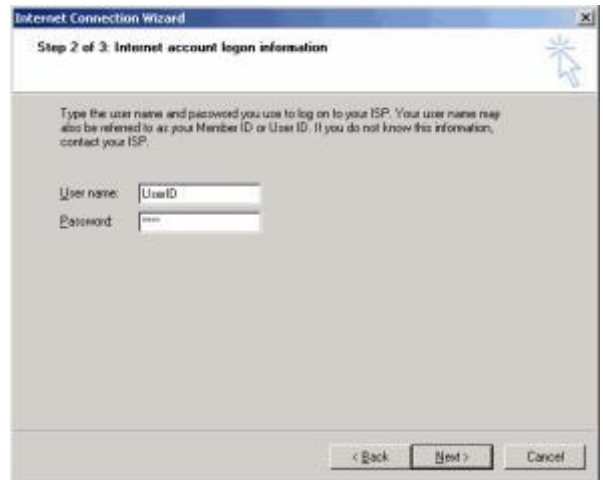
15. Click the **Next** button.



16. In the **User name** field, enter in your **username**.

17. In the **Password** field, enter your **password**.

18. Click the **Next** button.



20. For the **Connection name**, type in **bvillemn**.

21. Click the **Next** button



22. The Connection Wizard will then ask you if you would like to set up your Internet Mail Account. You may set it up if you like, or if you select **No**, you can set up your email account later.

23. Click the **Next** button (If you chose to set up your mail account, you will have to go through that wizard now.



24. Click the **Finish** button

25. In the **Network and Dial-up connections** window, double click the **bvillemn** icon to connect to the Internet.
