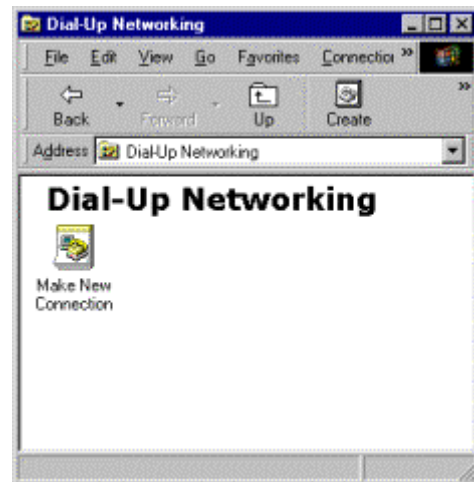


Windows 98 Dialup Settings

1. Double-click the **My Computer** icon.
2. Double-click the **Dial-up Networking** folder.



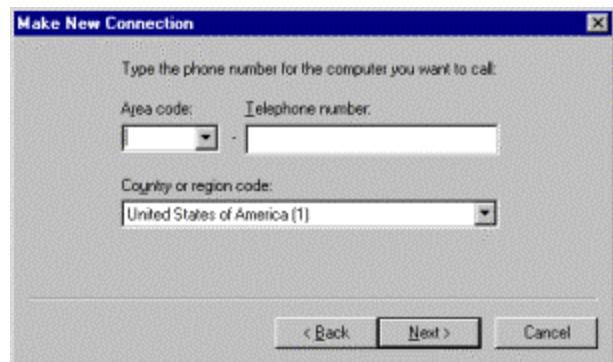
3. Double-click the **Make New Connection** icon.



4. Under Type a name for the computer you are dialing type **bvillemn**
5. Click the **Next** button.



6. Leave the Area code box blank and in **354-2220** in the Telephone number box.

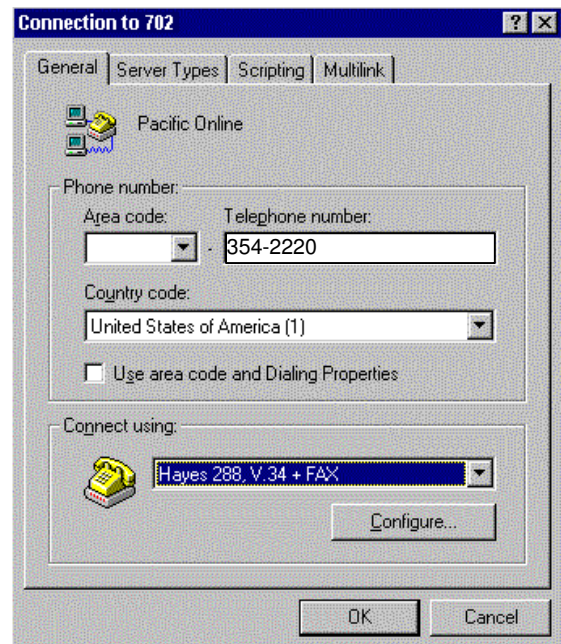


7. Click the **Next** button.

8. Click the **Finish** button.

9. Next, in the **Dial-up Networking** window, right click on the **bville** icon and click **Properties**.

10. Click the **Server Type Tab**.

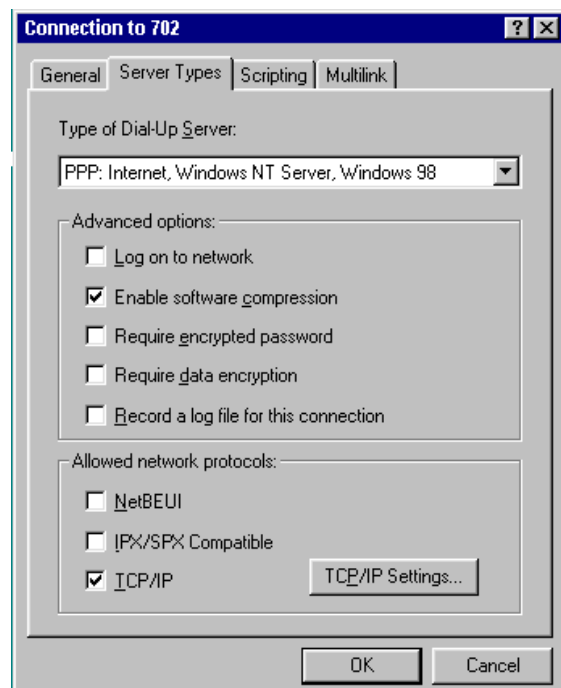


11. For **Type of Dial-up Server**, select **PPP:, Internet, Windows NT Server, Windows 98**.

12. The only option under **Advanced Options** that should be checked is **Enable Software Compression**.

13. The only protocol under **Allowed Network Protocols** that should be checked is **TCP/IP**.

14. Click the **TCP/IP Settings...** button.



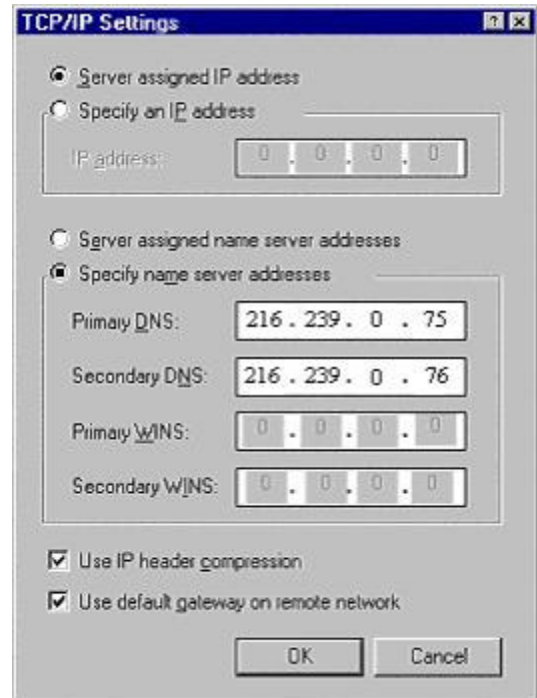
15. Make sure **Server assigned IP address** is selected.

16. Select **Specify Name Server Addresses**.

17. Enter **216.239.0.75** in the **Primary DNS** field and enter **216.239.0.76** in the **Secondary DNS** field.

18. Make sure both **Use IP header compression** and **Use default gateway on remote network** are checked.

19. Click the **OK** button until you are back at the **Dialup Networking** window.



20. You will now be back at the Dial-Up Networking folder. You should see the **Make a New Connection** icon and your new **bvillemn**.

21. To connect double click your newly created **bvillemn** icon.



22. Enter your **username** and your **Password**.

23. Make sure **Save password** is checked and click the **Connect** Button to connect to the Internet.
