

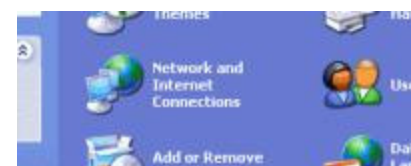


Windows XP Dialup Settings

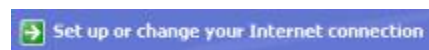
1. Click **Start**, then click **Control Panel**.



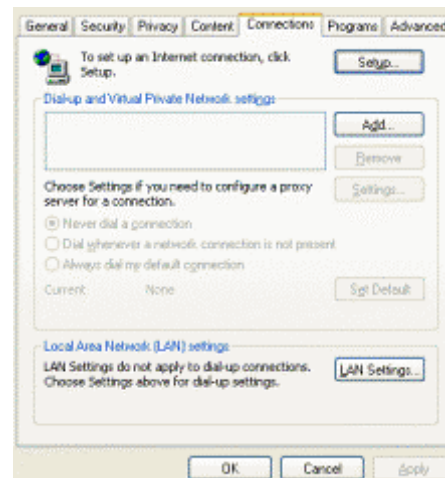
2. Click on **Network and Internet Connections**.



3. Click **Set up or change your Internet connection**.



4. Under the **Connections** tab, click the **Setup** button.



5. Click the **Next** button.



6. Select **Connect to the Internet**.



7. Click the **Next** button.

8. Select **Set up my connection manually**.



9. Click the **Next** button

10. Select **Connect using a dial-up modem**.




11. Click the **Next** button.

12. Type in **bvillemn**.



13. Click the **Next** button.

14. Enter **354-2220** in the phone number field.



15. Click the **Next** button.

16. Select either option (most likely for anyone's use).

17. Click the **Next** button.

**You may not see this screen, if you don't, go on to the next step.




18. Type in your **username** and **password** in the appropriate fields.



19. Check the box that says Add a shortcut to this connection to my desktop.

20. Click the Finish button



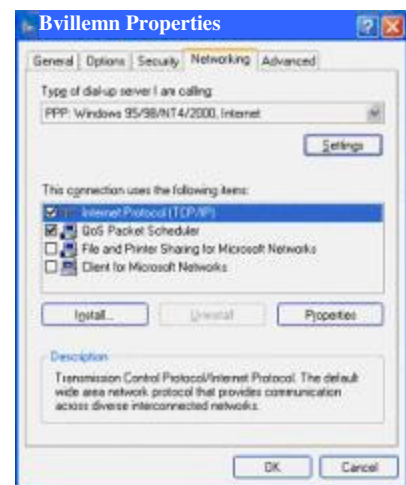
21. Double click on the newly created **bvillemn** icon located on your desktop.

23. Click on the **Networking** tab.

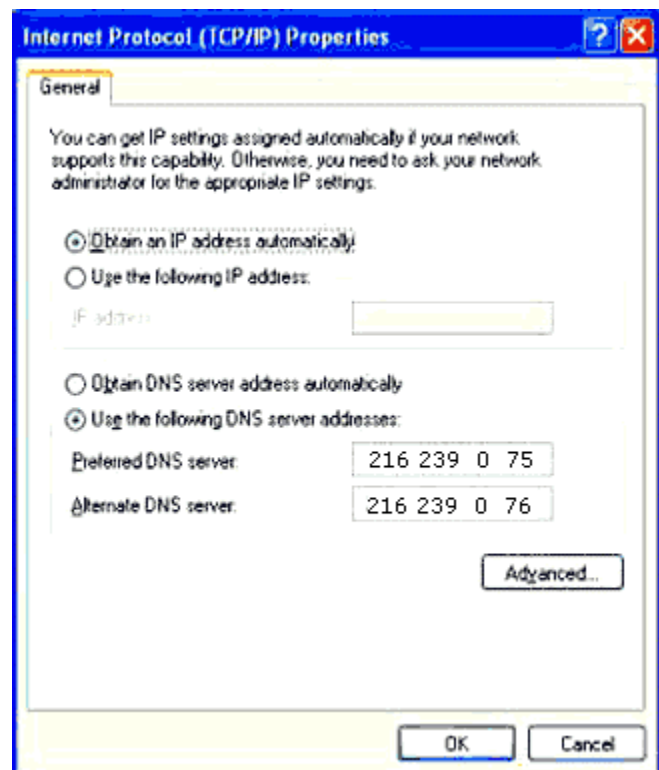
24. Select **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)** and click the **Properties** button.



25. Select Use the following **DNS server addresses**. Enter **216.239.0.75** for the preferred DNS Server and **216.239.0.76** for the alternate DNS Server.
